Each year, thanks to the hard work and dedication of its members and generous industry donations, the San Antonio API is able to offer a select number of scholarships to students in undergraduate degree programs. The application process is open to all potential and current undergraduate students planning to or currently attending an accredited post-secondary institution. Membership and participation in our local API chapter is strongly encouraged, but not required for receipt of a scholarship.

New applications are accepted once per year during the fall semester for the San Antonio API scholarship program. Please use the attached checklist and submit all required information and documents to the address on the letterhead above by no later than **July 15th**. Applications missing any of the required information will not be processed. In addition, those who fail to submit this information in a timely manner will not be eligible to receive an award for the upcoming academic year and will only be eligible for re-application in the following year for the fall semester.

Recipients of the scholarship receive their awards on a semester-to-semester basis. Scholarship recipients must submit their spring and fall semester grades and fall schedule by July 15th deadline. Current recipients must submit fall semester grades and spring semester schedules before January 15th.
